

PYM-RAE 2021

TESSERON ESTATE

VINTAGE :

The 2021 vintage reveals grapes of great concentration, developed during a dry yet steady season, which allowed for a beautiful balance between ripeness and freshness. In the vineyard, there was low intervention: nature guided the vines with precision. The harvest unfolded calmly, offering grapes of great intensity. At Pym-Rae, this vintage unveils the power of a land apart, shaped by the balance between tension and control.

WINE :

Intense red fruit aromas combine with notes of spices and dark chocolate. Pym-Rae 2021 also reveals itself the finesse of its silky tannins and an extremely subtle salinity. Aged 50% in new oak barrels and 50% in concrete vats.

ESTATE :

Nestled on the hills of Mount Veeder, hidden from views, above the fog, the Pym-Rae vineyard overlooks Napa Valley. Isolated and protected, it enjoys a temperate climate, caressed by cool Pacific breezes. Nights are warmer, and days are milder than in the valley.

SOILS :

On these volcanic and sedimentary soils, composed of tuff, sandstone, schist, and clay, the vines sink their roots deep in search of precious minerals. The winter rains of Mount Veeder make our dry farming approach possible.

Blend

75% Cabernet Sauvignon,
15% Merlot, 10% Cabernet Franc

Harvest

From September 22nd to
October 13th 2021
